Finding New Ways.....

Purpose of the process:

Sometimes to fix a problem or issue, we need to look at it from a different point of view.

Choose an important issue you hope to improve or fix. The issue can be from any topic you choose, such as work processes, equipment, work itself, resources change, etc....

2. I want to improve onsite communications.

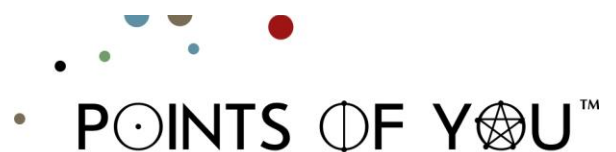
Once you're finished ...
